

## English

Our class novel this half term links to our History learning. We are reading 'The Ancient Egypt Sleepover' by Stephen Davis. In English, the children will be writing their own diaries and non-chronological reports linked to Ancient Egypt. The children will also be developing their handwriting, using a pre-cursive and cursive style.

## Physical Education

On Monday, our PE lesson will focus on skills linked to football. Children will learn how to dribble, defend, tackle and shoot. On Tuesday, the children will have PE lessons focussed on Dance.

## Outdoor Learning

The children will develop a range of skills in Walt's Wood with Mrs Townend on a Wednesday. Children may bring spare shoes, e.g. wellington boots or walking boots, to wear for this. As the weather could be wet, children may get muddy so spare clothes can also be worn!



## Mathematics

Children will be building on their place value knowledge when working with numbers to 1000. Later in the half term, we will be learning more about addition and subtraction with three-digit numbers. We will be continuing to learn our times tables and being able to recall these facts quickly,

## History

This half term in History, we will be learning about Ancient Egypt. Children will look at what life was like in Egypt, why the Nile was so important and other exciting areas, such as mummification. Children will also be exploring the role of gods and goddesses in Ancient Egypt and finding out more about Tutankhamun.

## PE Uniform

On PE days (Monday and Tuesday), children should come to school wearing their PE uniform. This includes: a plain navy-blue t-shirt with or without the school logo; plain black shorts, leggings or cycle shorts; plain black tracksuit bottoms; plain navy-blue sweatshirt and plain black trainers that are suitable for outdoor sport. On Tuesday, our PE lesson will be outdoors so please ensure children are dressed appropriately.

### Art

This half term we will be learning about sculpture. We will be using different materials to sculpt and carve. This topic will include a visit and workshop from the local sculptor, Simon Kent.

### Religious Education

This half term in RE, children will be finding out about what different people believe about God. Children will be able to identify some of the artefacts religious people might use and compare the similarities and differences between what people believe.



### Design and Technology- Nutrition and Healthy Eating

This half term, the children will learn about where different foods come from and the benefits of seasonal foods. Children will have to opportunity to try some seasonal ingredients before designing and making a puff pastry tart using seasonal fruits and vegetables.

### Music

In Music, we will be learning about ballads. Children will familiarise themselves with what ballads are before planning and performing a musical piece.

### Design and Technology- Textiles

In DT, we will be investigating Egyptian collars. Children will learn important skills such as cross stitch and applique before designing their Egyptian collar using a design criteria. Children will then follow their criteria to assemble and decorate their collar.

### Uniform Expectations

We will continue to uphold expectations for school uniform, including: A navy blue jumper or cardigan with or without the school logo; grey trousers, skirt or shorts; white or navy-blue polo shirt with or without the school logo; plain white, grey or black socks or plain grey tights; plain black pumps, trainers or shoes.
