

## English

This half term we will be focusing on both fiction and non-fiction writing.

We will be learning to write a Viking myth. We will also be learning how to write a formal letter of complaint.

## Mathematics

*In mathematics this half term the children will be focusing on multiplication. The children will develop their multiplication and division skills.*

*We will also focus on measuring in kilometres and meters, along with calculating the perimeter of shapes.*

## Outdoor Learning

In outdoor learning this half term, the children will be focusing on identifying and managing risks. They will also learn different knot tying skills and applying them to building a den.

*Outdoor learning will take place on a Wednesday. Please ensure that children are sent with weather appropriate clothing in addition to their school uniform.*



## Spanish

This half term in Spanish the children will learn about Spanish numbers, Spanish greetings and location knowledge.

## Art

During art this half term, the children will be focusing on sculpture. The children will be learning about Barbra Hepworth and will create their very own sculpture inspired by her work.

## History

In history this half term, the children will begin the topic, Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. The children will learn how the Anglo-Saxons ruled Britain and what life was like in Viking Britain.

## Music

The genre of music that we will be focusing on this half term in Samba. The children will learn about pulse and rhythm and build up to creating their own rhythmic breaks.

## Religious Education

In RE, the children will be continuing to focus on the journey of life and discussing the different events that can happen throughout the journey. The children will also continue to explore and identify different ceremonies that mark a significant occasion that happens during the journey of life.

## PSHE

During PSHE this half term, the children will learn about why we need money and how we can best manage our money.



## Science

In science this half term the children will be learning about sound. The children will identify how sounds are made and find patterns between the pitch of sound and features of the object that produced it.

## PE

During PE this half term, the children will be focusing on both dance and tennis.
