

## Science

Our Science topic this half term, is States of Matter. The children will learn about solids, liquids and gases and how materials can change states depending on temperature.

## PSHE

During PSHE this half term, the children will continue learning about why we need money and how we can best manage our money.

## R.E

In R.E this half term, the children will be focusing on the Hindu religion. The children will develop their knowledge of Hinduism and discuss what it means to be a Hindu in today's society.

## P.E

In mathematics this half term, the children will continue to focus on fractions before moving on to position and direction.

## English

## Art

## Geography

In Geography this half term, the children will be focusing on location knowledge. The children will be identifying human and physical characteristics as Russia. As well as, exploring vegetation belts and climate zones.
