This half term we will be starting our new class novel 'The Last Bear'. In writing, we will be focusing on a non-fiction and a fiction texts. We will be learning to write our own formal letters and balanced arguments, linked to the environment and our class novel.

Physical Education - Netball

The children will learn a series of Netball skills including passing, shooting and team building with Mrs Kay.

Geography - Place knowledge

This half-term in Geography, we will begin to focus on place knowledge. The children will understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of both local and foreign regions.



Modern Foreign Languages - Spanish

Religious Education

In RE, the children will continue to study the beliefs of Christians. They will identify what Jesus would do in relation to the 21st Century. They will discuss the key beliefs of the teachings of Jesus and the stories from the Bible.

Music - Composition notation

This half term in Music, the children will learn all about composition notation. They will focus on continuing to build their knowledge when playing different chords, as well as staying in time, rehearsing lyrics and performing a final piece relating to the Egyptian culture.

Art - Drawing and Painting

The children will be studying the artist Gustav Klimt. His style of art became known as symbolism. The children will learn and develop different art skills and create their own Klimt inspired artwork.
