This half term we will be linking our English writing to our Science learning. In writing, we will be focusing on an explanation text. We will be learning to write about the gestation period within the Human Life cycle.

Physical Education - Netball

The children will continue to learn and develop a series of Netball skills including passing, shooting and team building with Mrs Kay.

Modern Foreign Languages - Spanish

This half-term the children will continue to learn how to develop their Spanish oracy and written skills by learning different vocabulary and sentence structure.

Geography - Human and Physical Geography

This half-term in Geography, we will begin to focus on Human and Physical geography. The children will learn about settlements and different sources of power and energy.

Mathematics

This half term, the children will be continuing to learn about decimals and begin to learn about perimeter and area.

Continue to help at home by encouraging your child to recite their times tables and spellings.



Religious Education

In RE, the children will learn about different places of worship from different religions and why they have individual importance.

PSHCE - Health and Wellbeing

In PSHCE, we will be learning about our individual health and wellbeing and how this can be developed in the future. This unit will focus on topics such as healthy eating, medicine, drugs and puberty.

Music - South West and Africa

This half term in Music, the children will learn all about singing and pronunciation of music that was created in the regions of Africa. They will focus on continuing to build their knowledge of musical timing and rhythm (when following a piece of music).

Art - Drawing and Painting

The children will continue to study the artist Gustav Klimt. His style of art became known as symbolism. The children will learn and develop different painting techniques to create their own Klimt inspired artwork.
