

English

In our English lessons, we will be focusing on lots of familiar stories and how to write sentences from the stories. We will continue to focus on correct letter formation and using finger spaces. Each Friday, our lesson will focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar (SPaG). This half term will include using conjunctions, personal pronouns, verbs, adjectives, time connectives and using common exception words.

Science-

In Science, we will be learning about the seasons and the changes that occur in each season. We will learn how to identify different weather types and which weather is typical for each season.

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about human and physical geographical features. This will include learning what each of these terms mean, how to sort and categorise places into human and physical features and how to talk about them in detail.



Mathematics

The children will be focusing on addition and subtraction. We will be learning how to use part-whole models, find number bonds to 10, create fact families, find a part, find a whole and write number sentences. We use lots of practical activities in our maths lessons to help develop our understanding of number.

Physical Education

This term PE lessons will be twice a week on **Wednesday** and **Thursday**.

Miss White will be teaching Multi-skills on Wednesday which consists of throwing, catching and travelling, ect.

Mr Goddard will be teaching Basketball on the Thursday lesson.

Children will need to come to school wearing their PE kit which consists of:

- Plain navy-blue t-shirt with or without the school logo (no branded logos)
- Plain black shorts, leggings or cycle shorts (no branded logos)
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms (no pattern, branded logos etc)
- Plain navy-blue sweatshirt (no hood, no pattern, no branded logos)
- Plain black trainers that are suitable for outdoor sport.
- All soles and logos must be black.

Our library day will be on a Wednesday afternoon. If children wish to change their book, then they can bring it on a Wednesday morning along with their book mark and hand it to Mrs Millington. They are welcome to keep their book for more than one week.

PHSE

In PHSE we are going to be learning about being healthy. This will include how we can keep our bodies and mind healthy. We will also learn about how we grow from babies to adults. We will learn the differences between genders and how to stay safe in the community. This will include a Safe Touch talk from the school nurse.

Music

In music, the children will be learning about dynamics and tempo. They will learn what each of these terms mean and how to identify them in music. They will explore playing a range of dynamics and in different tempos.

Religious Education

In RE, our learning will be based around the question 'how are symbols used to welcome new life?' We will learn about the different ways that religions welcome babies. We will also be visiting St Peters Church to learn about symbols used in the Christian Church to welcome new life.

Art (Sculpture)

Mrs McCormack will be teaching the children how to create their own sculptures. The children will use a variety of materials creatively to design and make their own products. As part of their learning, children will look at the work of artists, craft makers and designers, noticing similarities and differences, and making connections to their own creations.
