

## English

This half term we will be starting our new class novel 'The Last Bear'. In writing, we will be focusing on a non-fiction and a fiction texts. We will be learning to write our own formal letters and balanced arguments, linked to the environment and our class novel.



## Physical Education - Gymnastics

## Design and Technology - Healthy Eating and Nutrition

Design and Technology - Nutrition  
This half term in Design and Technology (D&T), the children will learn about the importance of nutrition. They will be able to research the importance of a balanced diet, plan a soup that includes healthy ingredients and create the final product. As well as this the children will evaluate their nutritious soup and evaluate the importance this product has in the market today.



### Music - Composition notation

This half term in Music, the children will learn all about composition notation. They will focus on continuing to build their knowledge when playing different chords, as well as staying in time, rehearsing lyrics and performing a final piece relating to the Egyptian culture.



### Science - Living things and their Habitats

This half term in Science, the children will be learning about living things and their habitats. The children will investigate different life cycles and the conditions needed for animals to live and breed.



### Computing - Debugging and Algorithms

In Computing, we will be learning how use algorithms and debugging to create our own scratch projects.

### Art - Sculpture

The children will be studying the sculptor Alexander Calder. He is an artist who is known both for his innovative mobiles that embrace chance in their aesthetic. The children will learn the necessary skills to design, form and create their own sculptures.

This half term in PE the children will learn a series of Dodgeball skills, which include; learning how to aim, attack, defend and maneuver on a court.
