



### English

This half term we will be linking our English writing to our Science learning. In writing, we will be focusing on an explanation text. We will be learning to write about the gestation period within the Human Life cycle.

### Art - Sculpture

The children will continue to study the sculptor Alexander Calder. He is an artist who is known both for his innovative mobiles that embrace chance in their aesthetic.

The children will learn the necessary skills to design, form and create their own sculptures.

### Mathematics

This half term, the children will be continuing to learn about decimals and begin to learn about perimeter and area.

*Continue to help at home by encouraging your child to recite their times tables and spellings.*



### Physical Education - Athletics

The children will continue to learn and develop a series of Athletics skills including running, jumping and the hurdles with Mr Goddard.



### Physical Education - Cricket

The children will continue to learn and develop a series of Cricket skills including throwing, catching, bowling and batting.

### Religious Education

In RE, the children will continue to learn about the different values religions follow.

### PSHCE - Health and Wellbeing

In PSHCE, we will be learning about our individual health and wellbeing and how this can be developed in the future. This unit will focus on topics such as healthy eating, medicine, drugs and puberty.



## Music - South West and Africa

This half term in Music, the children will learn all about singing and pronunciation of music that was created in the regions of Africa. They will focus on continuing to build their knowledge of musical timing and rhythm (when following a piece of music).

## Art - Drawing and Painting

The children will continue to study the artist Gustav Klimt. His style of art became known as symbolism. The children will learn and develop different painting techniques to create their own Klimt inspired artwork.

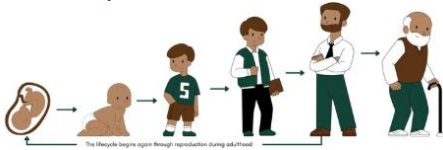
## Monday, Tuesday and Friday
