

English

In our English lessons, we will be learning how to write a report and poetry. This will be based on our class novel and books linked to our geography unit.

We will learn about a range of features before composing our own pieces of writing linked to each genre.

Guided Reading

The children will learn how to read a range of different texts across the year. They will learn how to understand a wider range of vocabulary, how to answer questions based on the information that they find in the text, how to predict what might happen next and how to articulate this in writing.

For children who access levelled phonics books, they will continue to be supported with this through phonics-style lessons with elements of guided reading linked to their phonics learning.



RE

This half-term we will be learning about how the bible helps Christians to live a good life.



Mathematics

The children will be learning about mass, capacity and fractions. The children will also continue to work through their times tables.



Physical Education

PE lessons will be on a Wednesday and Thursday this half term. The children will be taught by Miss Allison for tennis on a Wednesday and by Mr Goddard for dodgeball on a Thursday. Children will need to come to school wearing their PE uniform which consists of:

- Plain navy blue t-shirt with or without the school logo (no branded logos)
- Plain black shorts, leggings or cycle shorts (no branded logos)
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms (no pattern, branded logos etc)
- Plain navy-blue sweatshirt (no hood, no pattern, no branded logos)
- Plain black trainers that are suitable for outdoor sport. All soles and logos must be black.
- Children may wear a hat and gloves during cold weather

Please label all clothes clearly with your child's name.

Music

The children will be learning about pentatonic melodies. The children will learn about the history of music and then listen to songs that use pentatonic melodies before creating and performing their own pentatonic melodies.



Library

Our library day will be on a Monday. If children wish to change their book then they can bring it on a Monday morning along with their book mark and place it in the book basket. They are welcome to keep their book for more than one week. Any levelled books including bridging books will also be changed on a Monday.

History

In History, we will continue to learn about the Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age as this topic will stretch over two half terms.



Sculpture

Over the two half terms, we will learn about Sculpture with Mrs McCormack - our art specialist! The children will explore a range of sculpture artists and will visit the Yorkshire Sculpture Park on 6th March. Throughout the unit, the children will learn techniques to then support the design and building of their own structure.



Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about rivers, volcanoes and earthquakes. We will learn how to draw and label rivers using accurate vocabulary, describe the journey of a river from source to sea, learn how a volcano is formed, find out how earthquakes happen.



PSHE

In PSHE, we will continue to learn about living in the wider world including learning about bullying, antisocial behaviours and the consequences of antisocial behaviour. We will also continue to learn about money, spending and saving and value for money.
