

English

This half term we will be focusing on both fiction texts. We will be learning to write a Setting description and a Character description linked to the Ancient Greeks.



Physical Education

The children will learn and develop a range of skills linked to athletics with Mr Goddard on a Friday. These sessions will focus on improving techniques in running, jumping, and throwing, while also building fitness, coordination, an confidence through structured activities and practice.



Outdoor Adventurous Activities

The children will learn how to use the eight compass points and grid references to identify precise locations with Mrs Kay.



Spanish - Modern Foreign Languages (MFL)

This half-term the children will be learning how to structure their own sentences in Spanish relating to different greetings.



Mathematics

Children will be focusing on statistics during the beginning of this half term. They will learn to read and draw graphs and tables. Whilst also interpreting different types of data. They will also complete the shape unit, where they will identify, draw and compare different angles.

Continue to help at home by encouraging your child to recite their times tables, spellings.

Art

This half-term we develop children's understanding of symbolism. They will use their painting skills to add colour to create mood in their own designs. They will also use primary, secondary, complementary and contrasting colours to create effect.



History

This half term in history the children will focus on Ancient Greeks. They will learn the origin of the Ancient Greek civilization, what life was like during this time period and identify how the Ancient Greek civilization impacted human development.



Design and Technology - Textiles

This half term our D&T project will link to our history learning. The children will research, design, make and evaluate their own Ancient Greek Tapestry.



Monday - Thursday
