

## English

In our English lessons, we will be learning how to write a narrative and an information leaflet.

We will learn about a range of features before composing our own pieces of writing linked to each genre.

## Guided Reading

The children will learn how to read a range of different texts across the year. They will learn how to understand a wider range of vocabulary, how to answer questions based on the information that they find in the text, how to predict what might happen next and how to articulate this in writing.

For children who access levelled phonics books, they will continue to be supported with this through phonics-style lessons with elements of guided reading linked to their phonics learning.



## RE

This half-term we will be continuing our learning about how the bible helps Christians to live a good life.



## Mathematics

The children will be learning about fractions, money and time. The children will also continue to work through their times tables.



## Physical Education

PE lessons will be on a Friday for the rest of the year. The children will be taught by Mr Goddard and Mrs Kay. Children will need to come to school wearing their PE uniform which consists of:

- Plain navy blue t-shirt with or without the school logo (no branded logos)
- Plain black shorts, leggings or cycle shorts (no branded logos)
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms (no pattern, branded logos etc)
- Plain navy-blue sweatshirt (no hood, no pattern, no branded logos)
- Plain black trainers that are suitable for outdoor sport. All soles and logos must be black.
- Children may wear a sun hat during warm weather.
- Children must come to school wearing sun cream on warm days.

Please label all clothes clearly with your child's name.

## Music

The children will be learning how to play the recorder and read musical notation through this half term. They will learn about note names and note values and how to play in a range of tempo and dynamics.



## Library

Our library day will be on a Thursday. If children wish to change their book then they can bring it on a Thursday morning along with their book mark and place it in the book basket. They are welcome to keep their book for more than one week. Any levelled books including bridging books will also be changed on a Thursday.



## Science

In Science, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will learn about how animals and humans get nutrition from what they eat and how they need the right type and amount of nutrition. We will also learn about skeletons and muscles.

## Art

We will begin our Art unit about Vincent Van Gogh and will complete a study of his work using drawing and painting techniques,



## Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about the human and physical features of Egypt and England, making comparisons between the River Thames and the River Nile. We will also learn how to use aerial photos to identify features and how people can harm and improve the environment.



## Spanish

In Spanish, we will continue to learn how to say, read and write greetings and pets in Spanish.
