

English

In our English lessons, we will be learning how to write a narrative and an explanation text.

We will learn about a range of features before composing our own pieces of writing linked to each genre.

Guided Reading

The children will learn how to read a range of different texts across the year. They will learn how to understand a wider range of vocabulary, how to answer questions based on the information that they find in the text, how to predict what might happen next and how to articulate this in writing.



PSHE

This half-term we will be learning about transition. This will include learning about how to use a range of strategies to manage different emotions, to understand that change can bring challenge and opportunities and how to set goals.



Mathematics

The children will be learning about time including roman numerals and digital clocks, statistics, and shape. The children will also continue to work through their times tables.



Physical Education

PE lessons will be on a Friday for the rest of the year. The children will be taught by Mr Goddard and Mrs Kay. Children will need to come to school wearing their PE uniform which consists of:

- Plain navy blue t-shirt with or without the school logo (no branded logos)
- Plain black shorts, leggings or cycle shorts (no branded logos)
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms (no pattern, branded logos etc)
- Plain navy-blue sweatshirt (no hood, no pattern, no branded logos)
- Plain black trainers that are suitable for outdoor sport. All soles and logos must be black.
- Children may wear a sun hat during warm weather.
- Children must come to school wearing sun cream on warm days.

Please label all clothes clearly with your child's name.

Music

The children will be learning about traditional instrumentation and improvisation. They will be learning how to listen to, identify features of and create their own improvisations before performing to an audience.



Library

Our library day will be on a Thursday. If children wish to change their book then they can bring it on a Thursday morning along with their book mark and place it in the book basket. They are welcome to keep their book for more than one week. Any levelled books including bridging books will also be changed on a Thursday. All reading books will be collected in on transition week for the end of year.

Art

We will begin our Art unit about Vincent Van Gogh and will complete a study of his work using painting techniques to create a range of brushstrokes that are precise and planned. The children will work to create a piece of artwork inspired by Van Gogh's artwork.



Computing

In Computing, we will be learning how to use Carroll diagrams, collect and record data in a spreadsheet, create sorting diagrams and how to complete a data handling activity using images and text.



Science

In Science, we will be learning about rocks. They will learn how to recognise and compare rocks, how fossils are formed and recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.



Spanish

In Spanish, we will be consolidating our knowledge of how to count in Spanish. We will be learning how to read and write numbers in Spanish.
